

THE 15th SUNSHINE'S DAY – RULES

- the time shall be two 15 minutes halves, the clock is stopped only at free throws, substitutes and breaks In the last two minutes the clock is stopped at each time-out,
- an overtime lasts for 3 minutes. The clock, however, is stopped at each time-out -the team has the right to a 2 minutes' break ,
- the players are substituted freely,
- for those born in 2001 and younger there is no rule of 3 seconds, nor rule of the middle, at free throws the players are allowed to cross the line. They play in teams of four, with a ball of a normal size (leather or rubber) on a smaller court,
- those born in 2003 shall play with a small rubber ball, having baskets adjusted to a lower height and rules adapted; the matches will be mutually agreed among the coaches.

The main rule is FAIR PLAY. This rule includes:

- the manner of the player's play, the supporters' supporting, the referee's judging and the coaches' training,
- a dignified acceptance of defeat or victory, respectful and friendly attitude to all the participants,
- encouraging less competent and enjoying in one's own and other's successful moves,
- being enthusiastic about your performance since each team performs according to their competence and enjoys in the match.

The awards will be granted for FAIR PLAY behaviour.

A FREE THROW AND 3 POINTER THROW CONTEST

First the contest is held between the individuals within the participating teams, then the winners of individual groups are chosen. These winners will compete in the finals at the finishing spectacle of the 14 Sunshine's Day.

Boys, year 2001 and 2002 will compete in free throws. The first prize is a **pair of skis**.

In 3 pointer throws, boys and girls, year 1999 and 2000 will participate.

The first prize is a **mountain bike**.
